



# Outcome Tracking System

- The [Outcome Tracking System \(OTS\)](#) captures how people who receive developmental disabilities services in Ohio are spending their days.
- OTS provides valuable data that allows us to better understand what is happening for people with developmental disabilities in Ohio around employment-related and non-work-related supports.
- The OTS Reporting Period 2021 had a 71% statewide completion rate, and there was a 21% reported increase in Competitive Employment statewide.

## Competitive Employment

Competitive Employment is community, integrated work, performed on a full-time or part-time basis where the person is compensated at least minimum wage or no less than the customary rate paid by the employer, and is eligible for the level of benefits other employees are provided.



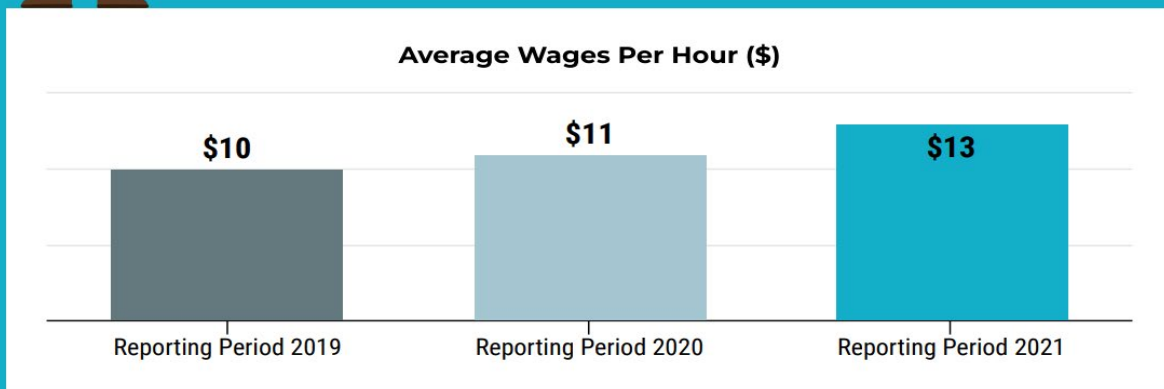
